Rajeev Sharma Fokeer was admitted to the English Bar as a Barrister in 2002 and was later admitted as Avocat à la Cour to the Paris Bar in 2005. He was also admitted to the Bar of Mauritius, his native country, in 2008.

He acts regularly in a number of institutional arbitration cases as Counsel in industrial and commercial disputes alike. He has also gained in-depth expertise in World Bank investigations and sanctions processes.
